All medical expenses for your dog as well as expenses that we may incur during the treatment of an injury will be the responsibility of the owner/owners. We will use a veterinarian of choice to handle the injury, depending on the availability. All balances due are to be paid in full at time of check out. NO EXCEPTIONS!
